2022 SCHOOL SWIMMING AND WATER SAFETY PROGRAM

- DATE:** Monday, 19th September – Friday, 23rd September, 2022
- VENUE:** Bomaderry Aquatic Centre
- TIME:** **Depart school** 12.45 pm – **Return to school** 2.45 pm
- COST:** Total Cost for the 5 day program is **\$15.50** which covers the pool entry. Our P&C are covering the cost of the bus for the 5 day program.
- WHO GOES:** Students in Years 2 – 6 who have not reached a satisfactory standard of water safety and survival skills and are unable to swim 25 m confidently unaided in deep water are eligible to participate in the School Swimming Program. The program focuses on weak swimmers in Year 2 to 6 as well as students with special needs such as new arrivals in Australia and students with disabilities.
- TRAVEL:** Bus
- DETAILS:** Arrangements have been made to include a learn to swim program in our school curriculum. The Department of Education and Training School Swimming and Water Safety Program is an intensive learn to swim program, which develops water confidence and provides students with basic skills in water safety and survival. The Program is conducted over five days. Each daily lesson is 1 ½ hr. Students will be assessed during the School Swimming Program for all water safety skills without wearing goggles.
- WHAT TO BRING:** Each child should bring a swimming costume, a towel, shirt, hat, sunscreen and a plastic bag for wet swimmers. A T-Shirt or rash shirt for swimming is also required. If students require goggles, these need to be provided by the parents.
