

ANZAC Memorial Soil Collection Project



The ANZAC Memorial Centenary Project will commemorate the centenary of the end of World War 1. A memorial artwork will be established at the Hyde Park Memorial in Sydney which will include the creation of a plaque for



every suburb and locality around NSW that enlistees for the First World War gave as their place of address. A sample of soil collected from the area will be displayed alongside the place name. Close to

1700 plaques will be displayed on mass around the walls of the Hall of Service. Terara Public School is proud to be a part of this project. Students have collected soil from our school site, near our Memorial Garden, representing the town of Numbaa as the town of enlistment.
