It is a partnership between The Bundanon Trust, Sydney based *Theatre Kantanka*'s artistic director Carlos Gomez, and guest artists, including Katia Molino. The artists have engaged with local communities to re-examine their city through diverse artforms to capture the spirit of Nowra and create an intriguing art event for its people.

Carlos worked with twelve of our Stage 3 students to produce sculptures and a soundscape, while Katia worked with eleven of our Stage 2 students on a read aloud performance of their writing to be presented live during the event.
