Music Lessons for 2018

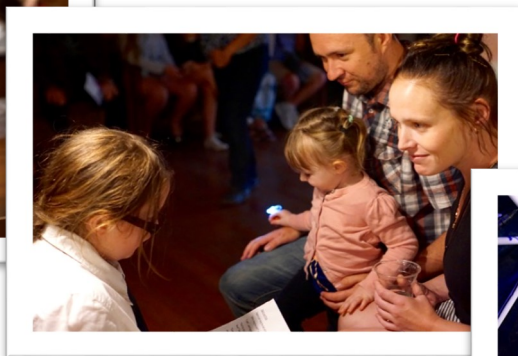
