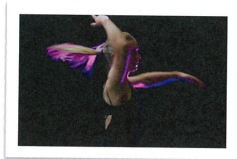
## Yr 7 2019 Showcase

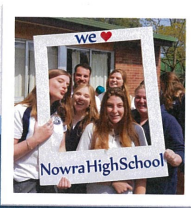
Parents and prospective Year 7 students for 2019 are invited to attend our school's information evening.
