Road Safety Work Complete

Thank you to Shoalhaven City Council for all their efforts in helping to make drop-off and pick-up safer for the students at Terara Public School. Work is finally complete to ensure that traffic conditions provide a safe environment when students are entering and leaving the school. The changes began when we were successful in our request to change bus routes so that students were dropped off and picked up without having to cross the road. Changes were then made to the parking bays and bus zone so that buses could pull in without obstructing traffic, and finally, road markings were put in place to create a safer flow of traffic in the immediate area of the school. These markings include double unbroken lines which prohibit cars from overtaking or making U-turns. Please observe all new traffic and parking regulations which now apply in our school zone, for the safety of our students.
