Students will also participate in Doing Things Together Day celebrating Aboriginal culture during Education Week, and they can wear the colours of the Aboriginal flag; red, black and yellow, on this day. We will also have open classrooms during the week to show off our flexible classroom furniture and share our learning in technology with the new robotics equipment.


Shoalhaven Music Festival
