2018 SWIMMING & WATER SAFETY PROGRAM

Arrangements have been made to include a learn to swim program in our school curriculum.

This program is an intensive learn to swim program which develops water confidence and provides students with basic skills in water safety and survival.

The program is conducted over ten days from **Monday 19th November—Friday 30th November.** Each daily lesson is 45 minutes.

Students in Year 2 –6 who have not reached a satisfactory standard of water and survival skills and are unable to swim 25 m confidently unaided in deep water are eligible to participate in the program.

The cost for this program is \$27 which includes daily bus transport to and from the pool and pool entry.

Participant numbers are limited to 30 students.
